



Update on the CSO South Interceptor Force Main Project

The South Interceptor Force Main Project is now under construction.

The existing South Interceptor Force Main was constructed in the early 1960s and has remained in continuous operation for approximately 50 years. The current condition of the existing South Interceptor Force Main makes it unreliable for continued long term use and replacement is necessary to convey dry and wet weather flows to the Missouri River Wastewater Treatment Plant. The new South Interceptor Force Main will provide this needed reliability in addition to increased flow capacity.

Schedule:

The South Interceptor Force Main will be constructed in three segments: North, Central, and South. Construction for the South and Central Segments is now underway. Central segment construction (Pierce St. to Hickory St.) is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2014. South segment construction (Hickory St. to the Missouri River Wastewater Treatment Plant) is anticipated to be complete by the fall of 2015.

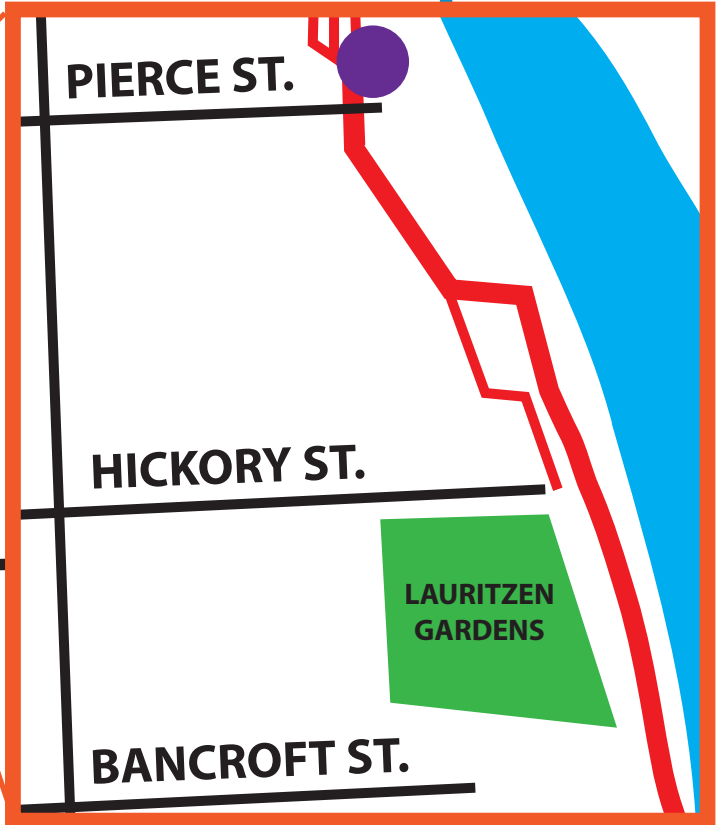
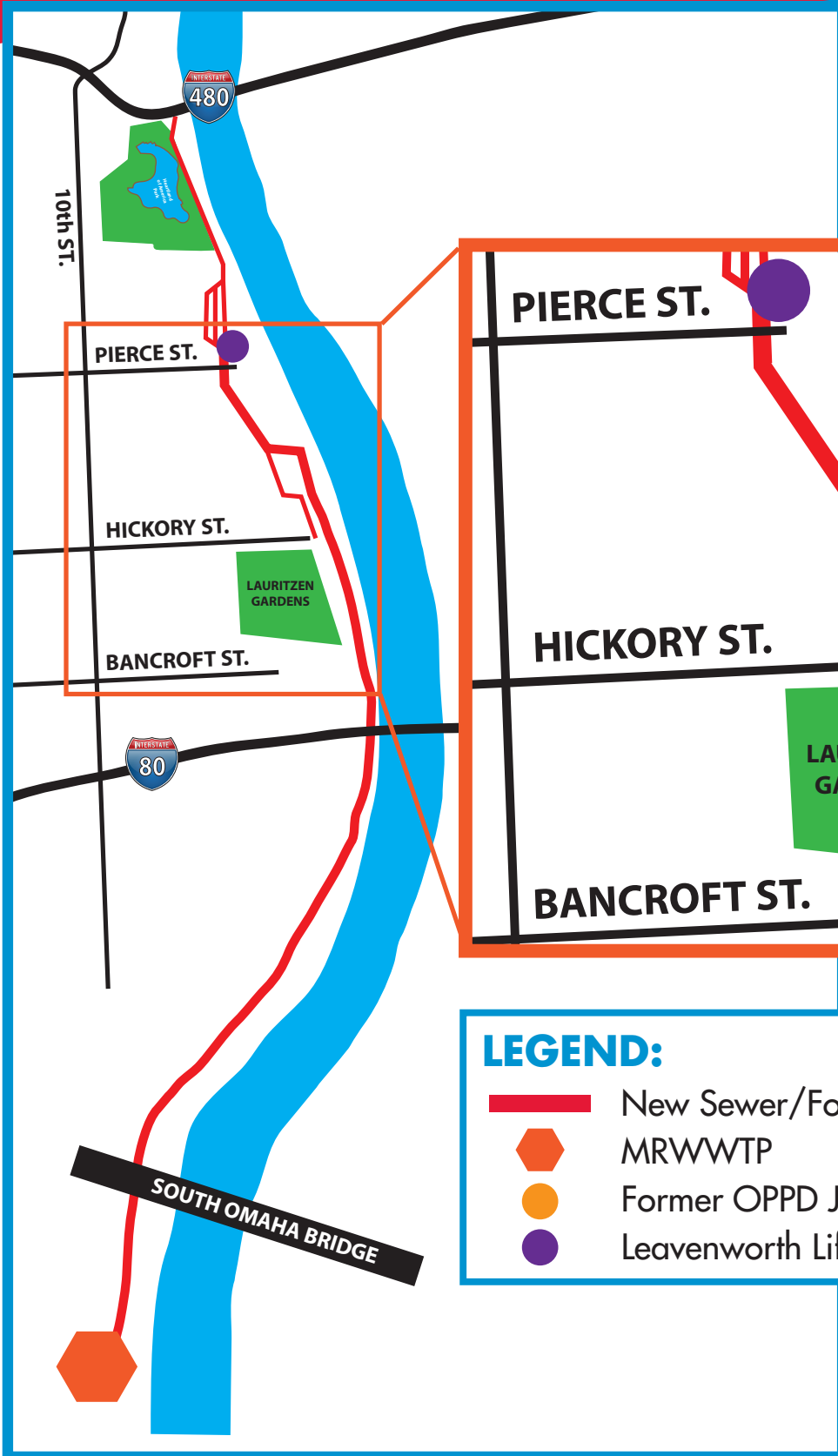
