PROJECT LOCATION:

- In the Ohern/Monroe Basin, along the Field Club Trail; just north of Interstate 80 and west of the South Omaha Silos



The green infrastructure program was adopted by the City as part of the 2014 Long Term Control Plan Update and included project opportunities in City-owned parks.

The Vinton Street Green Infrastructure Project constructed a subsurface detention facility near 35th and Vinton Street to manage the flow of stormwater into the existing sewer system. Detaining this flow assists with capacity in the downstream system.

This project was built in coordination with the adjacent South Omaha Trail improvement project.
