

Papillion Creek North CSO 210 (PCN 210) Sewer Separation Project



PROJECT SCHEDULE:

- This project is currently in the Final Design phase. Construction is expected to begin in the second or third quarter of 2021.



PROJECT LOCATION:

- In the Papillion Creek North Basin, the project is bordered by Maple, Blondo, North 60th and North 67th Streets

The PCN 210 Sewer Separation project is located in the Papillion Creek North Basin. It is bordered on the north by Maple Street, on the east by 60th Street, on the south by Blondo Street, and on the west by North 67th Street.

This project includes the construction of a combination of new sanitary sewer and new storm sewer to provide complete separation to the area. In 2002 a combined sewer renovation project (RNCL 5788A) was completed in the area of 61st and Lake Street.

This project may include the use of trenchless construction in specific areas to reduce impacts of construction on adjacent structures.

Project Benefits

This project will either convert the existing combined sewers to separate sanitary or storm sewers, depending on the most cost effective solution. It will ultimately result in reduced risk of sewer backups into area homes and reductions in combined sewer overflow volume into Papillion Creek.
